

Space Power Consortium (SPC) Executive Steering Committee Charter:

The Space Power Consortium (SPC) Executive Steering Committee shall comprise representatives of space-going government agencies, their prime contractors, and such first-tier suppliers of avionics and spacecraft power subsystems as are voted onto this committee by the SPC membership.

The SPC Executive Steering Committee shall provide overall direction and guidance to the OASIS standards body. Such guidance will include both technical and organizational structure, goals and objectives of the SPC standards.

The SPC Executive Steering Committee shall charter SPC technical Working Groups to perform the technical work, meet technical goals and objectives, and to develop technical standards and associated documents.

The SPC Executive Steering Committee shall be responsible for review, ratification and adoption of OASIS technical standards and associated document.

In order to perform this function, the SPC Executive Steering Committee shall engage their parent organization(s) in review and adoption of these standards in parent organization programs and projects.

The SPC Executive Steering Committee shall charter working groups that further the business objectives of the SPC standards body on an as-need basis. Such groups may perform functions such as: coordination with other technical and standards committees, marketing and outreach.
